Scooters and Bikes

A few families are beginning to bring children's scooters and bikes onto site and allowing children to ride around. Please do not bring these to school, as there are a great many children moving around the site at all times of the day, especially at the start and end of the day, and at Nursery changeover times at mid-day, and we need to ensure that no-one is injured in a collision with a bike or scooter. If you do bring them with you, please ensure that your child does not ride on them until you have left the school site.

Some of the path ways are very narrow and get very busy and bikes and scooters can cause accidents and injuries to other people.

Cars in school Grounds

The only time when parents should bring their cars onto school grounds is when they are collecting a sick child from school, or coming to breakfast or after school club.

At all other times parents must not bring cars onto school property.

Parents bringing children to afternoon Nursery, or collecting children from morning Nursery, or bringing a child to school late, or collecting them early must park on the road outside school and walk down the drive.

Children are moving between buildings at all times of the day, and we need to ensure that they are safe doing so.

The car park is not large enough for the extra cars, and we need to ensure that there is always access for emergency vehicles and deliveries to the school.

Dogs on site

Please be aware that the whole of our school site is a dog free zone, with the exception of guide dogs. Please leave your pets at home when coming to the school. This is in the interests of safety for all who use the site.
