Anti-Bullying Week

Next week is anti-bullying week in school. Children will learn about what bullying is and what bullying isn't. We use the acronym STOP to support children's learning. Several Times On Purpose — Bullying is not a one off incident. Start Telling Other People — We want all of our children to tell us about the things that worry or upset them. Two of our behaviour values are: We show respect to everyone and We choose kindness (this includes kind hands, kind feet and kind words).

Tuesday 12th November - Odd Socks Day

Children can come to school wearing odd socks to celebrate what makes us unique. There is a special song that we will be learning with Andy from CBBC.

Friday 15th November - Children in Need Day

Children can come to school in their own clothes for a charity donation. We will learn about how our money will help other children in England.
