## Listen to a story every day

- Download the CBeebies Story time app. <https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/storytime-app>
- Share books together. Ask your child to point to the words as you read them.
- Play a shopping game which helps your child think about how words sound. Line up 5 or 6 food tins from your cupboard. Give clues for your child to guess which one you want... eg for a tin of soup you could say;  
 Clue number 1 – “It has one word”  
 Clue number 2 – “The word has one syllable (or clap)”  
 Clue number 3 - “The word begins with ‘s’”  
 Clue number 4 – “The word sounds like ‘boup’”

Help your child to write their name or letters from their name every day. Writing letters with your fingers in flour or salt is great fun!
