#### Reading Challenge

- Read a book in a strange place (in the bath, under a table, in a tent)
- Practise your sounds and blend words. Play Dragon's Den <a href="https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/member-only/DragonsDen.html">https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/member-only/DragonsDen.html</a>
- Listen to a story on, Storytime.
- Create a bookmark, perhaps you could choose characters from your favourite stories.
- Can you find some instructions around the house and read them out?



## Writing Challenge

- Write your address: Discuss with your child. Discuss the postcode and any capital letters?
- Do they know who delivers the post? If you have a used envelope can they see any numbers on the front or back of the envelope? What do they mean? Who is the envelope addressed to? Ask your child to write their address on an envelope.
- Write some sentences using some of the Year 1 common words today, your, they
- Write the months of the year
- Write a letter or postcard find out about different postcards and why people write them. Can they design the front of the postcard and then plan what to write and who they could write it too?







## Maths Challenge

- Practise writing numbers 1 20 (numerals and words)
- Practise counting in 5's all the way to 100
- Go on Education city and play two of the Maths games
- Go on a shape hunt around the house. What shapes can you find?
- Count forwards to 50 and backwards to 0



## Challenge Time

Support your child to find out your address. Can they find the number on your door? Can they
write the number in digits and words? Ask them to try writing the number using crayons and
paint.

Can they write a postcard or letter to a teacher at school? They could tell their teacher about where they live and things about their local area.

• Can you have a teddy bear's picnic in the garden with your family? Make some jam sandwiches and sing some songs like; Twinkle, twinkle, I'm a little teapot, Humpty Dumpty. Can you act out the story 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' to your family?
