Activity 3 – Toilet Roll Easter craft!

What you will learn: To hold and use scissors with control. Know how to fix materials together. Lots of words to describe position such as under, top etc

What you will need: Toilet rolls!! Scissors, glue and anything can get hold of to decorate.

What to do: Look at the ideas below. There are so many things you can make with a toilet roll! You could make families of different sized bunnies or chicks. Could you make bunny puppets? If you haven't got lolly sticks you could use twigs from the garden or spoons. If you have paint at home you could do bunny printing too. Can you make a basket with a handle?



Activity 4 – Can you make up Easter Hunts around the house and garden?

There are lots of different ways you could do this.

- Write simple clues e.g. ‘Look in the room where you clean your teeth’
- Hide different coloured egg shapes around the house and each family member is given a colour. First to find all their eggs is the winner!
- Make up rhyming clues. ‘The place you need to look starts with ‘b’ and sounds like red’ (bed)

Listen to sounds in your garden and make a sound map.

Find a place to sit outdoors. Mark a cross in the centre of a piece of paper to show where you are. Sit still and listen carefully for a few minutes to all the sounds you can hear, then draw them on the paper to show where they are. Talk about your map with someone once you've finished. What was your favourite sound? Were there any sounds you didn't know?

Watch Sky TV. All you need is the sky!! Lie down on a blanket in the garden and watch the clouds. Get creative Tell a story to your family about the pictures and shapes you see in the clouds. Take a photo of a pretty sky.
