Activity 2 – Can you make up an Easter themed song and perform it to your family? Ask a family member to video you and watch it back.

Activity 3 - Weaving Easter Egg Decoration

What you will learn: I can cut materials using scissors.

What you will need: 1 piece of card, pens or pencil, coloured strips of papers, tape

Words to use: weave, thread, under, over, wool, ribbons, fold

What to do:

First get a piece of card and draw a large egg shape in the middle.

Next cut out the egg shape.

Then fold your egg in half and cut some slits to the middle of the shape. Open out to create your weaving slots.

After that cut strips of papers and weave them through the slits.

Finally stick them on the back of your egg using tape.



Activity 4 – Write an acrostic Easter poem
