- Practise writing numbers 1 30 (numerals and words)
- Practise counting in 10's all the way to 100

- Find some coins in the house and identify them. Which coin is worth the most? Which is worth the least? How much have you got altogether?
- Practise your number bonds to 20 write them down. Challenge can you write the fact families?
