- Can you draw a picture of your dream house and label it?
- Write about what your dream house would be like. Will it have a big trampoline or a swimming pool in the garden?

Maths Challenge

- Practise counting in 10's all the way to 100. Can you count backwards too? This [game](#) could support this.
- Can you practice adding two 2 digit numbers together using the column addition? Use this clip to help you with the method. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ayFAh4VNMFA>
- Try doing additions with exchanging too. E.g when the ones total is bigger than 10. $37 + 25 =$ (So $7 + 5 = 12$, 12 is bigger than 10 so we will exchange 10 ones for 1 ten.)
- Play on [The Mental Maths Train Game](#) -practise adding, subtracting, multiplying or dividing.
- Play on [Number Fact Families](#) - find the addition and subtraction fact families for numbers up to 20, 50 or 100.

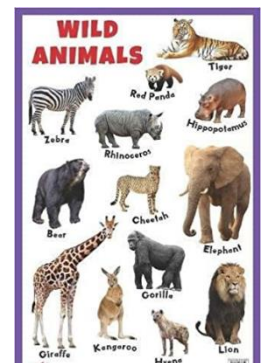


Challenge Time
