Activity 7 – Find out about a famous astronomer. Can you write a fact file about them?



Activity 8 –

Get in the garden – Go on a scavenger hunt for some resources (sticks, leaves, flowers, pebbles, sand, dirt).

Make a star picture using natural resources from the garden. You could ... go BIG and do a huge star or you could do lots of little stars.
