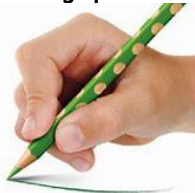
### Listen to a story every day

### Phonics

It's important that your child enjoys playing with words

Play guess the fruit or vegetable...  
 Using the clues below can you guess the fruit or vegetable

Pear-begins with p, rhymes with bear, has 1 clap and is green/yellow.

### Our Wonderful World

Green colour hunt - Can you find green objects around your house? Put them on a tray or plate and talk to your grown up about what you have found.

Memory game – Use the green objects on your tray. Look carefully and try to remember all of the objects. Cover the tray with a tea towel and ask your adult to take something off the tray you looking. Whip off the tea towel and guess the missing object! You can make this game trickier by adding more objects and taking more than one object away. **Improving your memory will make you a better reader!**
