Reading

Listen to a story every day

Writing

Use the letter formation sheet on the home learning page and practise your name every day.

Hold your pen or pencils with a pincer grip like this



Draw and label a picture of a rainbow together.



Maths

Count your garden leaves, flowers and sticks. How many have you found of each one? Can you find this number on your number line?

Can you use your leaves, flowers and sticks to make a repeating pattern? E.g. stick, leaf, stick, leaf, stick, leaf..

Phonics

Spot the mistake..
Adult to sing a simple rhyme or song, but make a mistake.

Twinkle twinkle little ..hat (should be star)

Incy wincy spider climbing up.. an orange (should be spout)

Can you spot the mistake?

Colour hunt – Have a walk, skip or hop around your garden. How many colours can you spot? Can you spot a green leaf? A yellow or orange flower? Or maybe a brown twig? Collect the items you find and place them on a tray or on the ground. Talk to your grown up about what you have found.
