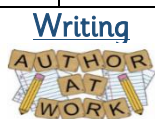

- Create a bookmark with the following common words on...push, we, are. See if you can spot any of these common words when you do your daily read.
- Listen to the story 'Superworm' by Julia Donaldson, https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=7Jnk3XApKBg&list=RD7Jnk3XApKBg&start_radio=1
Discuss your favourite part of the story with a grown up. What can you tell your grown-ups about the words 'toad' and 'road'. I wonder if you can share what an author and illustrator are?
- Watch and listen to Mrs Orme read 'Where is Caterpillar?' See you there!

- Practise writing the date each day.
- Create a story map for 'Superworm'.
- Write the word bug. How many rhyming words can you think of? Create a list.
