



# Home Learning for children with SEND

## Communication and Interaction



- Spend time everyday sitting and talking to your child.
- Children thrive on routine and structure and love to know what is happening throughout the day.
- Share a story with your child everyday. Talk to them about what is happening in the story. Ask them simple questions about the story - <https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/storytime-app>

## Cognition and Learning



- Practice writing your letters of the alphabet. Make sure you use your 'froggy' fingers! Remember to start each letter in the right place!
- Start everyday by practising your name and surname.
- Help your grownup to write a shopping list. Think carefully about all of the sounds that you can hear in each word.
- Play 'Eye Spy' inside and outside. Can you become the 'Eye Spy Champion' and guess the most words beginning with each different letter?
- Ask a grownup to shout out a number. Can you find the correct amount of...stones, leaves, flowers, sticks to match the number?!
