



# Home Learning for children with SEND

## Communication and Interaction



- Spend time everyday sitting and talking to your child.
- Children thrive on routine and structure and love to know what is happening throughout the day.
- Share a story with your child everyday. Talk to them about what is happening in the story. Ask them simple questions about the story - <https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/watch/storytime-app>
- Be a Sun Safe Superstar! Remember to Slip, Slap, Slop.
- Go to <https://youtu.be/T7ghJsZug60> and watch the story about George the Sun Safe Superstar.
- Ask your child if they can explain why it is important to be a Sun Safe Superstar!

## Cognition and Learning



- Practice writing your letters of the alphabet. Make sure you use your 'froggy' fingers! Remember to start each letter in the right place!
- Start everyday by practising your name and surname.

- Have a go at writing a word which begins with each letter of the alphabet!
- Go on a shape hunt around your garden and house. How many shapes can you find?! Make a list of the shapes you find. Practise writing each shape name and the amount that you found. Shapes are everywhere!
