- Write a set of questions about animals you would like to find out about. Can your grown up help you to find out the answers?
- Create a fact file about your favourite animal. Research an animal of your choice and explore the vocabulary required to describe them.
- Can you email your teacher your fact file- teach them some interesting facts about your favourite animal!

## Maths Challenge

- Practise counting in 3's all the way to 30. Can you write them in a number track? E.g 3, 6, 9 ...

- Play on [The Mental Maths Train Game](#) -practise adding, subtracting, multiplying or dividing.
- Play on [Number Fact Families](#) - find the addition and subtraction fact families for numbers up to 20, 50 or 100.
- Practise writing some of the fact families for number bonds up to 20. E.g  $13 + 7 = 20$   $7 + 13 = 20$   
 $20 - 13 = 7$   $20 - 7 = 13$
