- Did you enjoy this story? Write down your opinion of the story in a book review- draw a picture of the front cover, write which parts were your favourite, and write if you would recommend this book to someone.

- Draw a large colourful alien on a big sheet of paper. Use some words to describe what it looks like, what noises it makes, what is its personality like? Challenge- use words with the suffix ful, er and est.
- Is there an item that always goes missing in your house? Write a mini story and explain how they end up getting lost... use conjunctions like because, when, so to make your sentences longer and adjectives to describe the mysterious goings on.

With a family member, can you think of 4 questions that you would like to ask the aliens in the spaceship? Remember to use your R Time manners, taking turns and sharing ideas 😊
