Reading Challenge

- Listen to and read the Ugly Five book

- Can you spot the words with these suffixes- ing, ed, est and er For example- ugliest.
- Find all the adjectives used to describe the animals. Which ones are your favourite and why?
- Use a dictionary to find the meaning of new vocabulary.
- Can you find all the rhyming words in the book?
- Imagine you are one of the animals. What would you be thinking? How would you be feeling? What would you be saying to the other animals?
- Can you make some finger puppets and retell the story?

Writing Challenge

- Play a spelling game on Spelling City.
- Practise writing some of the Year 2 common exception words: great, behind, kind, mind, would, other, who, everyone, beautiful
- Imagine you are on a safari... What two animals can you see? Describe them using adjectives to see if we can guess what they are! Star challenge: Can you use new vocabulary learnt from the book?
- Imagine that the book is now called 'The Ugly Six'. Can you create a new page based on the sixth member of the group? Star Challenge: Can you use an adjective with the er or est suffix?

R - Time

Use the mood monster poster you have received this week and talk to a family member about what mood monster you are. How are you feeling and why? Think about the feelings words in the book, which ones are positive and which ones are negative? Ugly, graceful, divine etc.



Maths Challenge

- Practice counting in 10s from a random number i.e. 32, 42, 52, 62 forwards and backwards.
- Recap on telling the time to quarter past, half past, quarter to and o'clock.
- Can you look at the clock at different points in the day and make a little diary? I.e. at 8:00 I ate my breakfast, then at 10:15 I did some maths.
- Can you draw a treasure map and write some instructions of how to get to different checkpoints? Or you can test your friend on the directions they need to travel in. Use the vocabulary half turn, full turn, quarter turn, anticlockwise, clockwise.

What other animals live on the African plain? How are they suited to living in their habitat?


Make a food chain that includes some of the animals mentioned in the story. Can you label the consumer and producer?
