Reading Challenge

- Read every day!!!
- Listen to a bedtime story.
- Can you retell one of your favourite stories? Can you act it out?
- Can you read your reading book and change the endings?
- Have you got a book you haven't read before? Read the blurb and make a prediction about what you think this book will be about.
- Can you compare two of your favourite books? What is similar about them and what is different? Would you recommend them to anyone?

Writing Challenge

- Play a spelling game on Spelling City.
- Practise writing some of the Year 2 common exception words: move, Mr, Mrs, old, only, parents, pass, past, path, people.
- Write down some questions that you would like to ask your teacher.
- Write an email to your teacher. Let them know what you have been doing and anything fun you have done.
- Write a post card/ letter to one of your family/ friends. Write some kind words to make them smile.

 Write words to describe each family member
 Do an **EQUAL** amount of work!!



Maths Challenge

- Label some common 2D and 3D shapes.
- **Shape hunt:** Go a shape hunt around their house and garden. Look at the different shapes of the windows, doors, and houses. Can they name them? Are they 2D or 3D shapes?
- **Name the shape:** Place some 2D or 3D shapes into a bag and play the game 'Can you name the shape?' You will need a partner to play this game. One partner has a **shape** from the shape bag and they stand back to back. The partner with the **shape** describes it to their partner who has to try and draw it. How many do you know?
- Draw a repeating pattern of shapes. E.g triangle, square, pentagon, triangle, square, pentagon...

Create a booklet all about the family:

- Look at photographs of your family members and discuss where they would go on a family tree. Have you met everyone? Is there anyone you could interview and find out more about?
- Can they name the people in their family and write sentences about them? Who are they? What do they call them? What do they like or dislike? Why are they special to them? Maybe they could get a photograph or draw a family member before they write about them.
