Dexter is determined. When he makes a mistake, he learns from it and tries again.




Sparks

What will you make? Please email me your masterpieces.





Mrs. Dearie's Challenge is... READY STEADY LEGO!

CHOOSE kindness 


Mrs. Mills' challenge is... to make a memory box.
