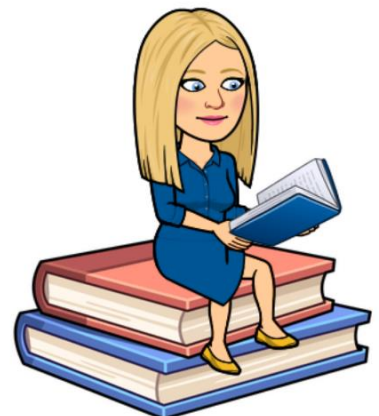
Dear Cavendish Close Children,

Well done to Isaac in Class 4- we love your super work to measure and order your broomsticks by length.



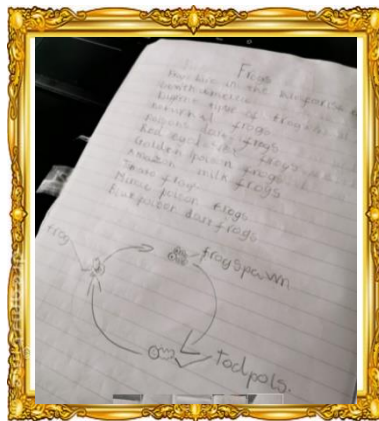
Amazing writing from Eriks in Class 5, who has a fantastic attitude to learning and always puts lots of effort in at home too.



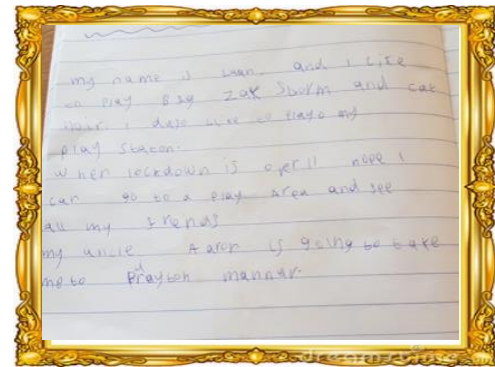
Well done to Lucas in class 6 who's been doing some super drawings linked to the 'Oi Frog' book.
