

Mrs Howett's Challenge

Draw a map of the story

Can you draw the story like a map? Start with the house and the oven and the Little Old Man and Woman. Draw the path the Gingerbread Man runs along. Can you draw the different animals he runs past?



Find out one fact about each animal in the story.

We learnt about nocturnal animals in nursery. Do you think foxes are nocturnal?

Have you ever been to a farm? What kinds of animals would you see in a farm?

Mrs Brown's Challenge

Gingerbread Family

Can you make a family of gingerbread men, big, medium and small?

Make your gingerbread family using play dough. What could you use for their eyes, nose and mouth? Roll a dice to help you decide how many buttons each gingerbread person will have. Take a photo and send it to the nursery email!





Mrs Panter's Challenge

Make a Puppet

Make puppets of each characters in the story The Gingerbread Man? You could use card from cereal boxes, glue and lolly sticks or materials like felt to make finger puppets.

Can you make a setting for the story? You could make a Lego house and oven, a path, grass and river.

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Now use your puppets to tell the story.



Gingerbread Man Investigation

Can you be super scientists and find out what would have happened if the gingerbread man had fallen into the river? You will need a bowl of water and gingerbread man biscuit. Place the gingerbread man into the water. What's happened? With the help of an adult you could even find out what would happen if he fell into a cup of tea or bowl of soapy water!
