Communication and Interaction



- Spend time everyday sitting and talking to your child.
- Children thrive on routine and structure and love to know what is happening throughout the day.
- Begin to talk to your child about what school will be like when they return. Talk to your child about social distancing and being mindful of this when they are in school. It is important to give your child the time to think about and process what school will be like when they return.

Cognition and Learning



- Practice writing your letters of the alphabet. Make sure you use your 'froggy' fingers! Remember to start each letter in the right place!
- Start everyday by practising your name and surname.
- Ask a grown up to write the days of the week. Have a go at copying each day. Can you write each day in the correct order all by yourself?! Have a go at writing one sentence for each day of the week. "On Monday I....."
- Have a go at making your very own number line using numbers 0-20. Can you write all your numbers the right way round and in the correct order? Ask a grown up to use counters to cover up some of the numbers. Can you correctly guess the missing numbers?!
