

Writing Challenge



- What questions would you ask Burglar Bill if you interviewed him?
- Can you create a word bank of adjectives to describe what Burglar Bill and Betty look like?
- You have been hired as a police detective. Please write a WANTED poster so that people can catch these criminals! Make sure you give specific details of what they're wearing, where they were last seen, what key items they carry round with them. What reward will you give?
- The two burglars decided that they wanted to give back all the things they'd stolen and be much kinder. Imagine if you carried a kindness bag with you wherever you went. How would you use your bag to brighten up people's day? Be creative! Draw it, label it and explain in detail how it works.

R - Time



Burglar Bill decided to change his attitude and correct the wrong things he had done, because he felt guilty about how he'd hurt people. Is there something in your life that you would like to change? How could you help someone out every day? What would you do if your friend was making the wrong choice? How would you help them?



Maths Challenge



- Burglar Bill likes to visit house numbers that end in 5 or 0. What times table do you see these numbers in? He also likes house numbers that are even numbers. What numbers could he visit?
- What items have you got in your sack? Can you see how many g or kg each item weighs using scales? How much does your bag weigh in total?
- As part of your job as a police officer, you must record what times Burglar Bill is seen around the area. Make a report of where he's been spotted throughout the day and draw the clock faces. I.e. He was seen outside the post office at half past 12.
- Burglar Bill took the baby for a walk at 5 o'clock. He went out for 2 hours. What time did he get home? At half past 7 he made his dinner and he had a bath at half past 8. How long did it take him to eat his dinner? He went to bed at 10 o'clock. How long was he in the bath for? Draw the clock faces to help you. Have a look at how the minute and hour hands change.

- Burglar Bill likes to drink lots of hot drinks when he's out. Can you design him a new travel mug with the most suitable materials to keep the drinks warm. Can you investigate which material is the best **insulator**?
- Burglar Bill is **very** active at night and so are many animals. A cat is a nocturnal animal. Can you research some other nocturnal animals and create an information poster?



- Burglar Bill has some old objects in his house that are from a few **decades** ago. Can you spot anything that looks old or you haven't seen before? Find out what it is and what its purpose is. Make a list to compare objects in houses from this era to nowadays.
- Lots of scenes from Burglar Bill are drawn at night. Can you create a picture of a starry night? See above for a painting that was created by the artist Van Gogh
