




What do I need to do?


Draw and decorate 1 little house on paper.

## What size?

Start with a square piece of paper that is 10cm x 10cm. Children, have a go at measuring your own. Your house must be 10cm wide and up to 10cm tall (you choose the height).


Use bright colours like the ones on this chart. These are known as primary and secondary colours.





This square has a width of 10cm and a height of 10cm.

The house must be 10cm wide but as tall/ short as you like (up to 10cm).

## How shall I decorate it?

Your house can:

1. Look like a real house (think of all the features you find on a house)

OR

2. Be abstract-You could use the artist Kandinsky to inspire your mini house.


The houses look most effective when there is no white paper left showing.

Use any things you have at home: pens, crayons, tissue paper, paint.



## How do I submit my artwork?

Take a clear photograph of your house.
