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Dear Parents and Carers

I am going to start this week's newsletter with some wonderful news. We have new baby twins in our school community. Busy times ahead for such a lovey family!

In today's newsletter, you will find out who will be your child's teacher in September. You will also find out which Teaching Assistants will be supporting your child. In addition to the class based staff, Mrs Leadbeater, Mrs Dearie, Mrs Roberts and Mrs Smalley will continue to teach and support children across school

Thank you to the parents and carers who are safely ordering uniform from the school office remotely. Your cooperation is appreciated. The office will arrange safe collection with you directly.

Next week, you will receive your child's end of year report. Your child's current teacher will attempt to ring you, one last time, next week to discuss the report and to say goodbye and good luck! If you miss the call, you can get in touch with us by telephone or email. When reading the reports, I was staggered by how much our children achieved between September 2019 and March 2020 when school partially closed. All of our children are Super Star Leaners.

Along with your child's report, you will also receive a fabulous summer learning pack to keep your child busy and learning this summer.

We are looking forward to welcoming back all of our children in September, however, there will be many strict safety measures in place. We are currently working our way through 'Full School Return' Risk Assessments which need approving by the Local Authority, Elite Safety in Education and our Governing Board. We are also working on our 'Full School Return' Plan which again needs to be approved before we can share information with parents and carers before the end of term. Here are some of the likely safety measures that we will implement to keep our school community as safe as possible.

- There is a one way system in and around school.
- Children will need to be brought to school by one adult only.
- Classes will have staggered start and finish times. All children will access 5 hours of teaching time
- Your child will not need a PE kit for the first half term. All PE will happen during 3 daily outdoor learning sessions.
- We are working towards offering hot meals with a simplified menu.
- We are working towards offering our Breakfast Club and After School Club with restrictions in place.
- Parents and carers will not be able to enter school and must respect social distancing.

Further details will follow when our plan has been approved by all staff groups and Governors. You will be sent a 'Keeping Safe at School' booklet to share with your child to prepare them for how school will be the same and different. Thank you for your patience.

School meals for children in school

We reopened our kitchen on Monday 6th July, and we are providing a packed lunch for all the children in school who would like one. Children eat their dinner in their classroom bubbles. Mrs Carter and the kitchen team have worked hard to ensure that the highest standards of safety, hygiene and organisation are in place. They have worked as a team to get the kitchen up and running again. Thank you, ladies, – We have missed you! The packed lunches have been enjoyed and appreciated.

- If your child attends school for 4 or 5 days a week and they are eligible for benefits related Free School Meals, you will not receive a £15 supermarket voucher for the weeks beginning 6th July and 13th July as we will be providing your child with a meal in school.
- If your child attends school for 3 days or less each week and they are eligible for benefits related Free School Meals, you will continue to receive a £10 supermarket voucher for the weeks beginning 6th July and 13th July. For the days that your child is in school, we will be providing them with a meal in school.
- For the week beginning 20th July, all eligible families will receive a £15 supermarket voucher. All children in school will be provided with a meal.

Today is the last day that you can email us a photo or a short video of your child for the special end of Year 2 video. We would love all Year 2 children to be a part of creating this special memory.

Supporting children eligible for benefits related Free School Meals

We have 100 children that are eligible for <u>benefits related</u> Free School Meals and they have been benefitting from the Government's national voucher scheme. Shopping vouchers are emailed directly from 'Edenred' (the Government's chosen voucher supplier) to eligible families.

Eligible families will receive a £90 voucher, per eligible child, for the summer holidays. Eligible parents and carers should receive these vouchers on Friday 17th July. We know that sometimes these emails have been delivered into 'spam' boxes so please check there. We also know that some vouchers have not been redeemed and will expire soon, please ensure that you redeem these vouchers so that your child can benefit from this scheme.

All e-Codes have an activation date and cannot be used until that date. All e-Codes are 16 digits long. If you encounter difficulties redeeming your vouchers, you can email 'Edenred' directly:
