


Nursery - Home Learning — Week beginning 06.7.20

Make play dough

Can you make some porridge play dough?

Play dough recipe:

1 cup of salt, 1 cup of flour, 1 cup water.

Mix dry ingredients together then add water. Knead until smooth. Add your porridge oats. Keep covered in a container in the refrigerator.

Can you make three bears using your play dough? Have a go at making a daddy bear, mummy bear and a baby bear. Which one is the smallest? Which is the biggest?
