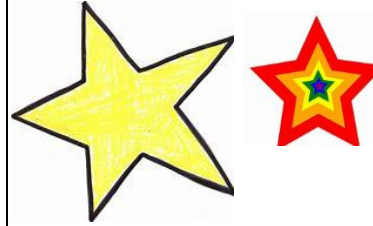




There is still time to make a house. Make sure it is no wider or taller than 10cm!
