Listen to a story every day

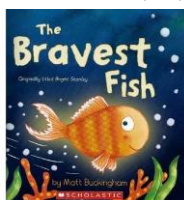

- Is the biggest object the heaviest? Can you weigh your objects and put them in order – from the lightest to the heaviest!



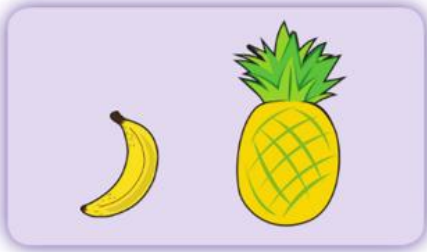

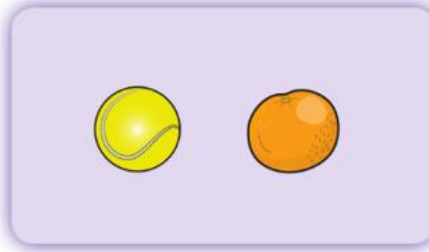

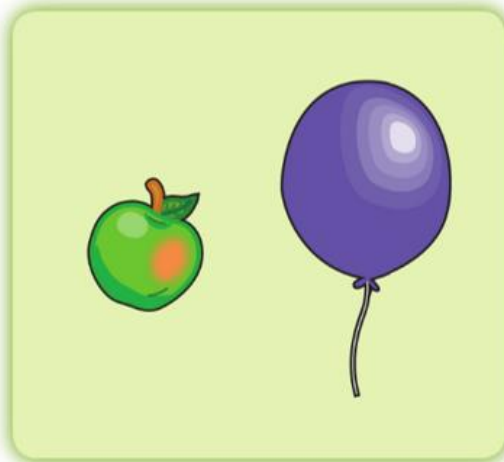
