'First and Then'

- . In school we use the language of 'First and Then' in our activities, children like to know what is going to happen after they have done their work!
- If your child finds something tricky, knowing they can do something they enjoy after may help to keep them focussed.
- For example 'First we are going to do some counting, then you can draw a picture'
- You and your child could make a 'First and Then' board with pictures so that they can see what is coming next.

'Countdown'

- Knowing there is an end to an activity can really help. children who are struggling to stay focussed
- You can use any sort of timer for this for example, a sand timer, a phone timer, YouTube have lots of timers with fun music!
- Learning in short bursts may help your child to stay motivated and knowing that there is a time limit on the activity that they are doing will help, especially if it is not their favourite job!









Strategies to motivate and encourage your child during home learning.

'Star chart'

- In school we use sticker charts to reward children for good behaviour and learning, children love seeing how many stickers they have earned
- If you don't have stickers at home you could draw on a smiley face, a star or a favourite animal!
- You could reward your child with a 'star' each time they follow your instructions or do a great job with their learning
- If your child has a full chart, they could choose a reward for example, some time on a tablet, watch a film or have a picnic in the garden!

'Positive Praise'



- . Children really respond well in class to the use of positive language, such as 'I love the way you are sitting nicely today' or 'I know you're going to make the right choice
- This is a lovely way to get children focussed and start the day in a positive way
- Pick out the things your child has done well for example, helped you to clear away after breakfast or got dressed by themselves and praise them positively
- In school if we feel a child isn't making the best choice we stick to positive language and give them a chance to turn it

South America

South America is the fourth biggest continent in the world.
