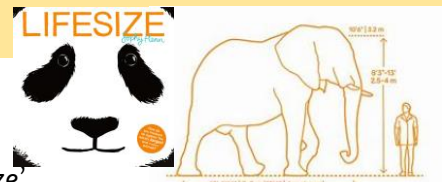
Today is Maths Day.

How much money do you have in your money box? Can you sort the coins in your grownups purse? Create a shop using your toys. Can you give change?

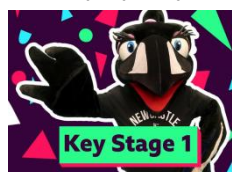
