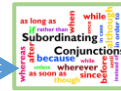

## Writing Challenge Aim: Write for different purposes and learn about India

**Starter activity:** Remind yourself how to use subordinating conjunctions here: →

**Main:** Using all the information you found out yesterday design a travel leaflet to advertise India. Checklist- have you used:

- Expanded noun phrases with a comma. These descriptive words give the reader more information so they can imagine what you are saying. E.g Large, gentle elephants.
- Subordinating conjunctions such as: 'that', 'because', 'if', 'when'. These make sentences longer and give more details.
- Clever punctuation '!' for expression or '?' for questions. And of course Capital letters and full stops.
- E.g Do you like adventures? Visit the impressive, majestic buildings of India in the continent of Asia, that take you on a journey back in time. See the terrifying, stripy Tigers if you like to learn about India's fascinating world of animals!

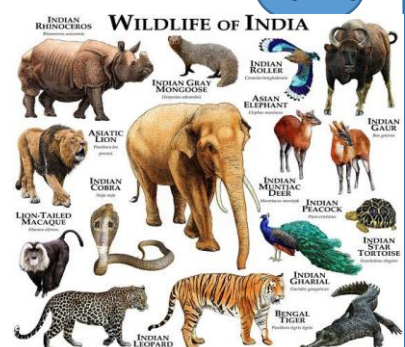
