Well done Jenson!



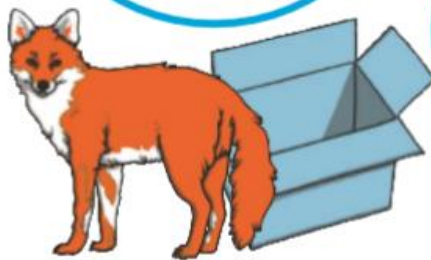
Rhythm and Rhyme Home Learning Challenge
