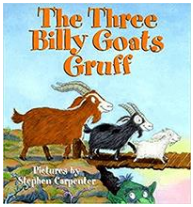


Reception - Home Learning

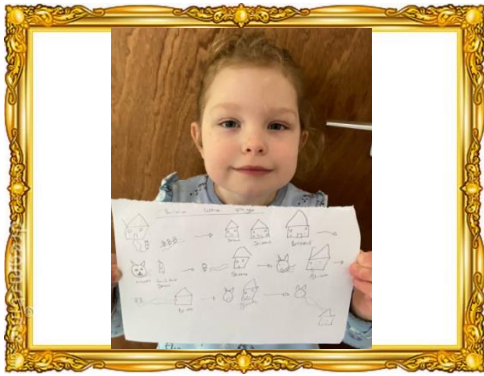
Look at our fantastic work from Reception last week...

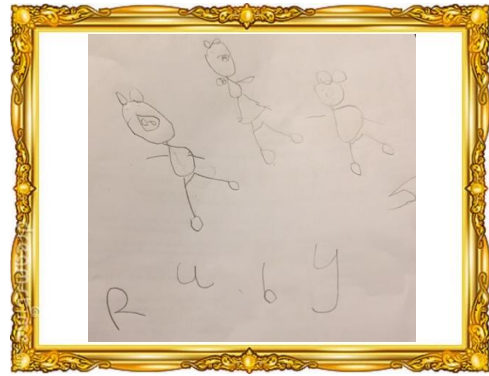
