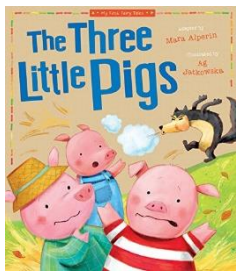


We hope that you are enjoying our new topic for this half term. Can you tell a story beginning and ending with 'Once upon a time....happily ever after?'

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<p><u>Word Wise</u></p> <p>Letters and Sounds</p>	<p>Today's focus is the phoneme (sound) nk. Sometimes 2 graphemes (letters) stand side by side to make one sound.
