This grapheme is called a split digraph. A digraph is two letters that go together to make one sound (phoneme).

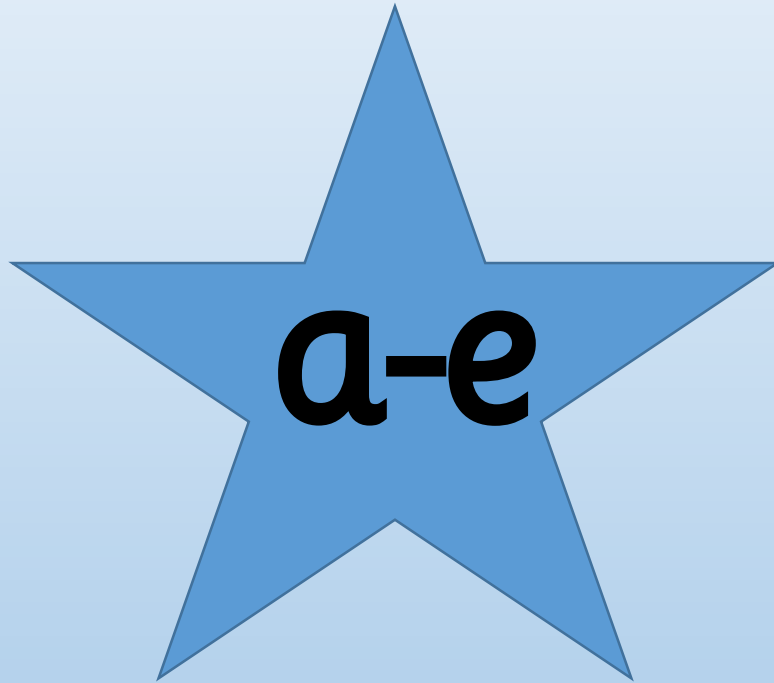
A split digraph has a sound (phoneme) in the middle that splits it.
