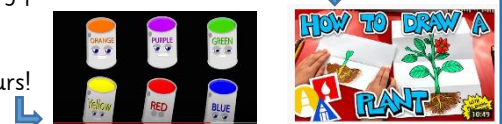

coniferous	Most conifers are evergreens, or trees that keep their leaves year-round.			<input type="checkbox"/> Seasons change throughout the year because of the way the Earth travels around the Sun.	
deciduous	Deciduous trees are trees that shed their leaves once a year, usually during the season of autumn.			<input type="checkbox"/> Parks and woods are rich habitats , home to thousands of species of animals. Trees and woods provide shelter, warmth, food and safe places to hide and to look after offspring .	
trunk	A tree's trunk holds up its crown, protects its inner parts and works like a pipeline, transporting essential materials to the different parts of the tree.			<input type="checkbox"/> Trees and shrubs take in water and carbon dioxide and give out oxygen.	
roots	It is the part of a plant that is usually hidden under the ground. They make the plant stable and give it nutrients.			<input type="checkbox"/> The trunk is the main body of the tree. The trunk is covered with bark which protects it from damage.	
evergreen	Evergreen trees are the same as coniferous trees. They do not lose their leaves in Autumn.				
stem	The stem is the main part of the plant.
