Checklist- have you used:

- Expanded noun phrases with a comma. These descriptive words give the reader more information so they can imagine what you are saying. E.g Large, gentle elephants. Cheeky, furry monkeys. Strong, horned bison.
- Subordinating conjunctions such as: 'that', 'because', 'if', 'when', 'but', 'or'. These make sentences longer to give more information E.g Marty sat on the roof of a speedy, yellow rickshaw when his weak, tired wings needed a rest. He deserved it after zooming over all those countries in Europe and Asia countries
- Clever punctuation '!' for expression or '?' for questions. And of course Capital letters and full stops.
