Writing Challenge Aim: Making a list of 'sentence starters'

Starter activity: Close your eyes and take yourself back to your nature walk in your mind.

Main: In preparation for writing your 'walk in nature narrative' tomorrow, lets create a list of 'sentence starters' to help us. Use the 'sentence openers word mat' on the school website. Choose at least 8 that you think would work well in your narrative and write them in a list. (Remember you are not writing full sentences today – just gathering useful 'starters' For example:

- **Whilst I was** walking...
- **In the distance** leaves fell like...
- **Across from** the field...
- **Next to** the squelchy mud...

- **Near** the pond...
- **I was surrounded** by towering trees...
- **A moment later** I heard...
- **Before long** the path...

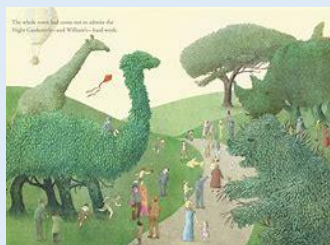
