Starter activity: Read all the information you have found out about India over the last few weeks. Marty the Magpie flew to India and was amazed with what he could see there. Make your own vocabulary map for flying. Write all the words you can think of to describe or are linked to 'flying'. E.g flew, soared, flapped, zoom.. Main: Draw a long path- this is Marty's journey -your story. Along the path draw or stick pictures, and add notes or words. What will he see or do when in India? Heres my story map as an example:
