Here is Sparks, one of our Power Maths characters. Helping and supporting your child through talk and play is the best way your child can learn.

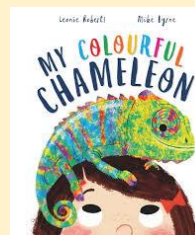


We have loved seeing photos of your learning but we are so excited to welcome you back next week. Here is a video to help you remember where to come!

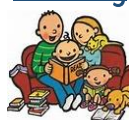
Enjoy being outside whatever the weather!
