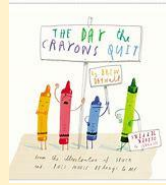


Hello and welcome back!

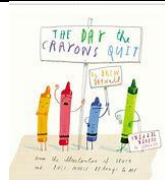
Enjoy being outside whatever the weather!

Chubby Little Snowman

(Teach this as a spoken word rhyme, or choose your own tune.)

A chubby little snowman,
(Holds hands out to demonstrate 'chubby')

Had a carrot nose,
(Point to nose)

Along came a bunny,
(Hop like a bunny)

And what do you suppose?
(Shrug shoulders; hold out hands, as if to question)

That hungry little bunny,
(Rub your tummy)

Looking for his lunch,
(Hold hand above eyes, as if for searching for something)

Ate that snowman's carrot nose,
(Make a bunny with one hand and a carrot with the other)

Nibble, nibble, CRUNCH!
(Make the bunny eat the carrot with two small bites
and a final big bite)
