<p><u>Word Wise</u></p>	<p>Today's focus is the phoneme (sound) ow. Sometimes 2 graphemes (letters) stand side by side to make one sound. We call this a digraph</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=G6u2dmsUYro&list=PLuGr6z2H2KNGrCOBaVFC23</p> <p>Can you write these words; cow, now, wow, gown, howl</p> <p>Play 'Picnic on Pluto' on Phonics Play. Select Phase 3 and phoneme 'ow'. HAVE FUN!</p>
