- This week's focus in handwriting is practising lower case letters. Here are the letters we are practising this week

Start with a c and then go upwards all the way. Go straight back down again and hooray - you made an a!	Start with a c then climb a tree. Come back down and you have a d!	To begin writing a g you need a c. Then go up and back down to make a tail for a monkey.	Start with a c, go up, then down, then what do you do? Go under the line then flick to the right to make a q!
