| Use of alcohol based anti-bacterial gel sanitiser | Staff Pupils | Accidental Consumption Incorrect use | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use of alcohol-based hand sanitiser must only be used by staff and pupils when hot soap and water isn't readily accessible or to be used in between washing of hands where possible. • If pupils are using the alcohol-based gel, you must ensure they use it correctly and there are no religious beliefs which prevent them from using or medical problems such as sensitive skin conditions. • If the school has purchased the sanitisers they should have a safety data sheet and a risk assessment for the product. • If pupils have been provided with the gel from Parents, they must be informed to use it sensibly in the school setting (or to use only when arriving and leaving the school site). However, you will not have to supply a safety data sheet as these have not been obtained direct from the school. | MED | | ✓ |
