




I love this book because it always reminds me that picking up or throwing away litter saves our planet.

Who do you think enjoys reading this book?




I like this book because it inspires creative writing.

Can you guess who loves this book?




I like this book because when the sun is shining, it makes me feel happy and puts a big smile on my face!

Can you work out who likes this book?




This is my favourite book because I love to bake delicious cakes and I like to have tea parties with my family. Also, my favourite animal is a tiger.

Who do you think likes reading this story?




I like this book because I have an allotment and see lots of worms. I love to be outdoors because I see lots of flowers, birds and insects like in the book.

Can you guess who loves reading this book?





Can you guess who I am?




I love this book because I have a family of foxes that visit my garden. I would love to live in the country because I love nature and science.

Who do you think likes this book?




This is my favourite book because it is about being a friend and remembering that I don't have to be big and brave all the time.

Who enjoys reading this book?




This is one of my favourite stories because I enjoy having fun outdoors.

Who am I?




I love this book because the pea is funny and I like to be funny. I work at lunchtime in the hall and children see me in the mornings when they enter the school grounds.

Can you guess whose favourite book this is?




This was one of the first books I read and is still my favourite today. The best part was when the caterpillar turned into a beautiful, colourful butterfly.
