This week we are focussing on the colour yellow and orange. Can you find a collection of



yellow and orange things in your home? Name the objects using phonic skills;

- 1. clap the syllables
- 2. emphasise the intial sound (phoneme) in the word
- 3. Think of a word that rhymes (it can be a nonsense word)

Can you sort your objects? Which have 2 syllables? Group objects with the same initial phoneme together.
