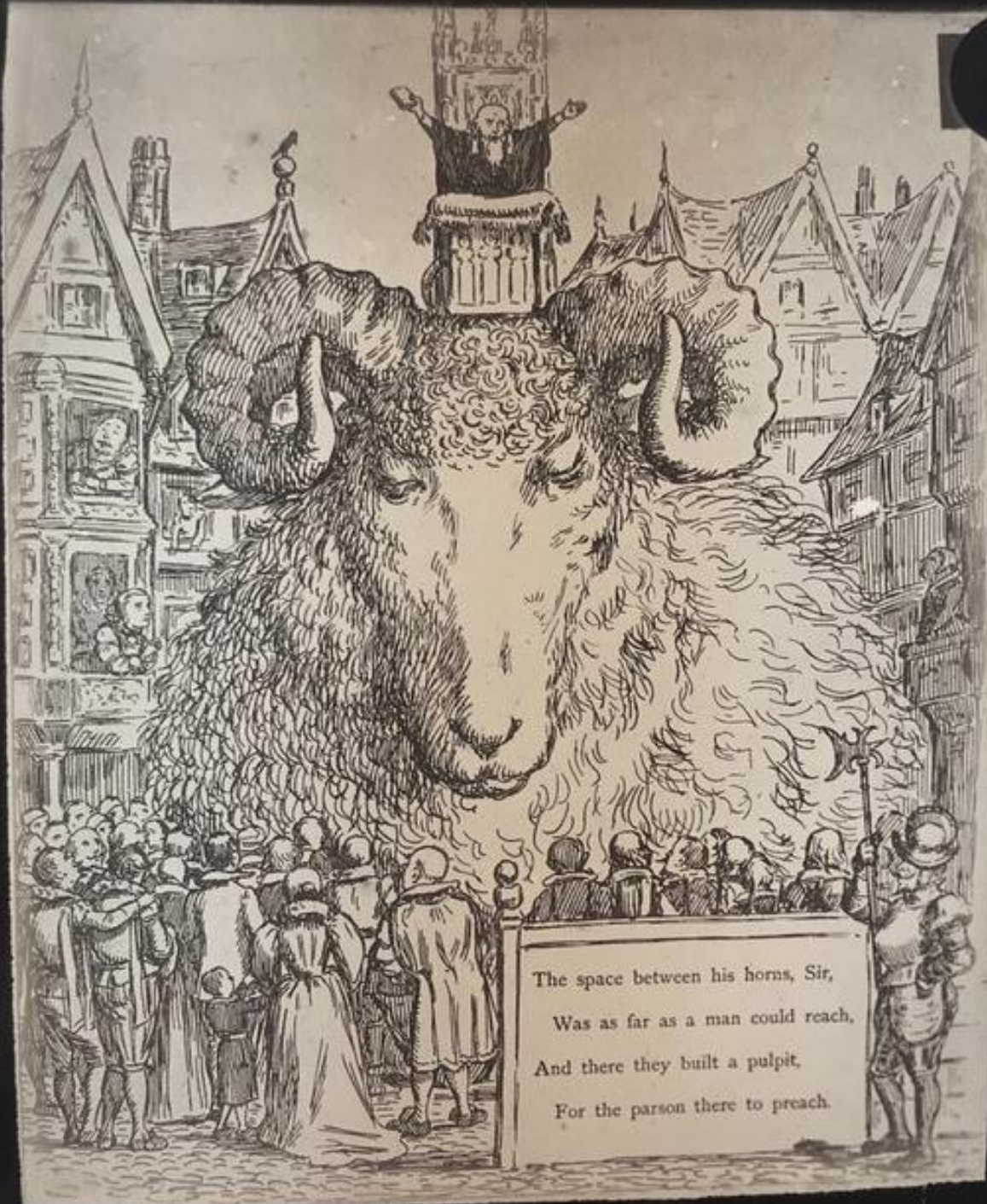
Here is a very

That ever was fed on hay.



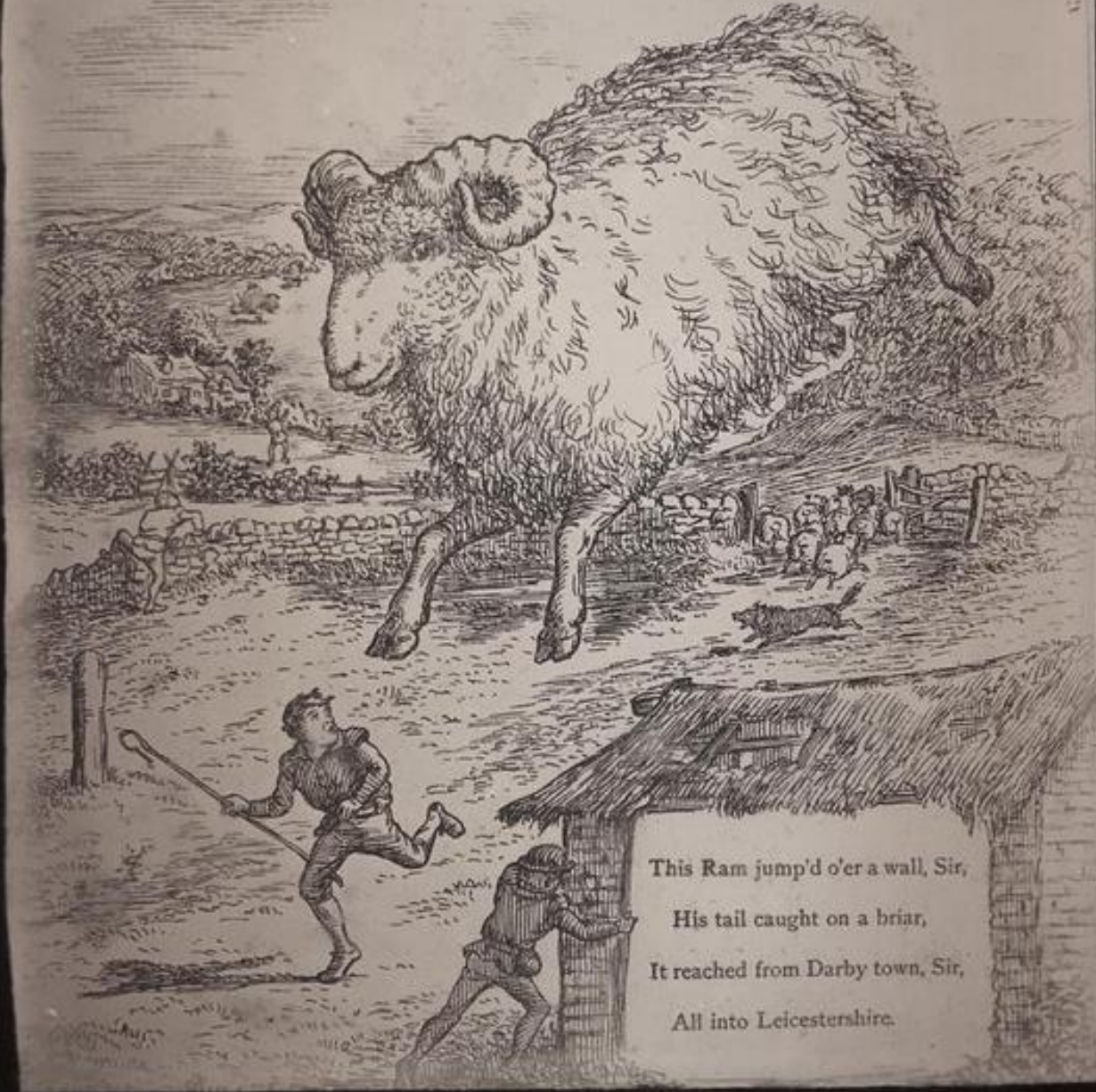
The wool upon his back, Sir,

again.

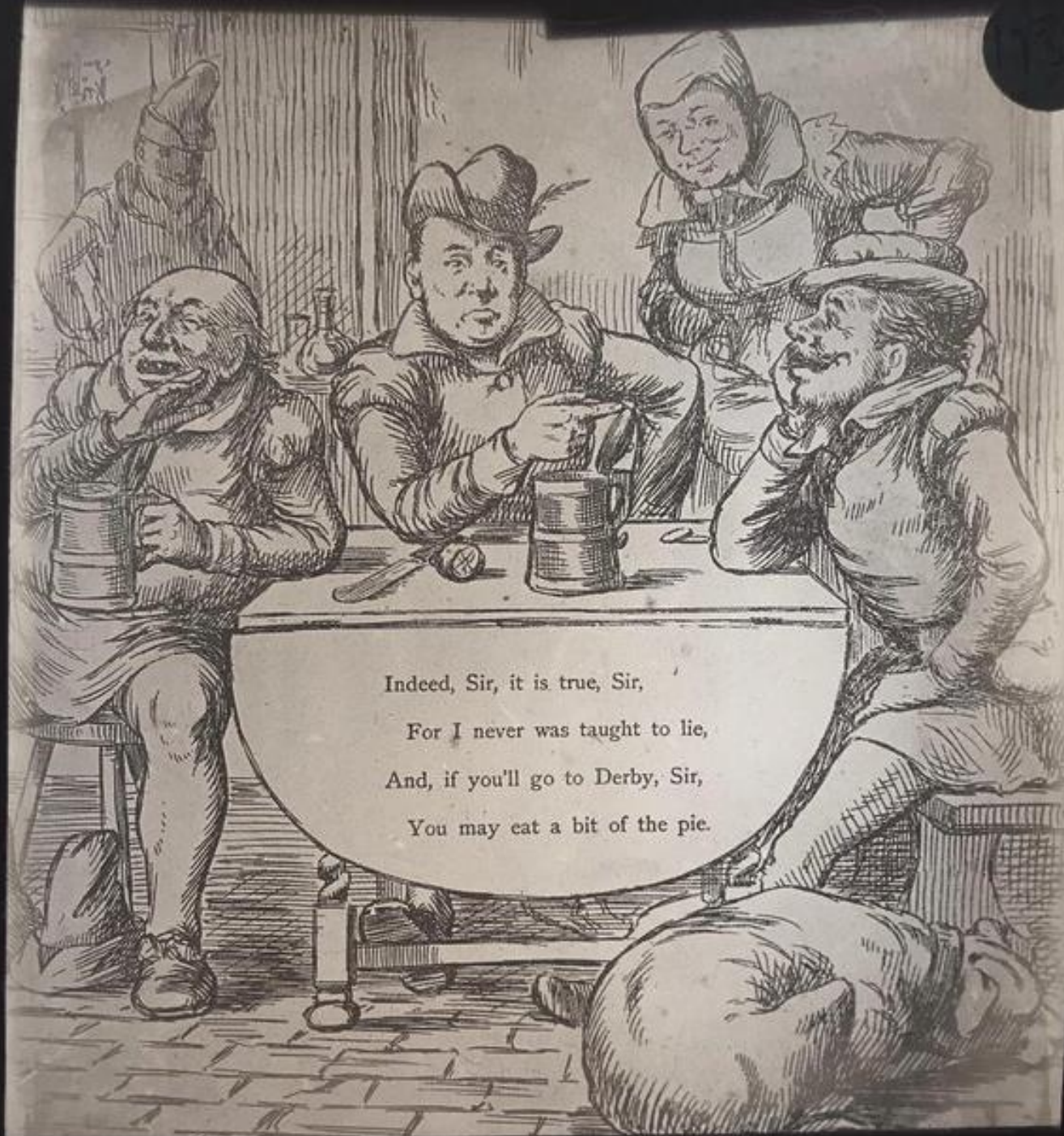


This Ram jump'd o'er a wall, Sir,

Design your own mini ram for the Schools' Mini Ram Trail!

From **27 May to 22 August 2021**, the Derby Ram Trail, a spectacular free public art installation is coming to Derby.

As part of the trail, your school is taking part in a city-wide school art competition, with the opportunity to get your child(ren)'s own ram design to feature in a Mini Ram Trail for Schools, at Derby Museum and Art Gallery.



To take part, we are inviting your child(ren) to design their own ram on the theme of *what is important to me, right now* on the 2D template provided.

The 2D designs will be judged in school, with winners of this round being invited to create their designs in 3D, by decorating a mini ram model. A panel of judges, including representatives from Derby Museums, Rolls-Royce and the Cathedral Quarter BID will then judge all 3D ram designs from schools across the city, selecting 30 to be featured in the Mini Ram Trail.

Use the template provided and hand back to your school to enter! Good luck!



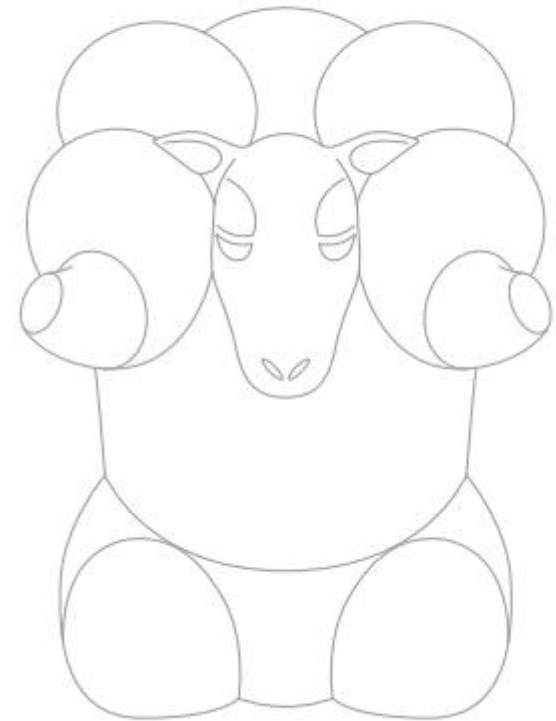
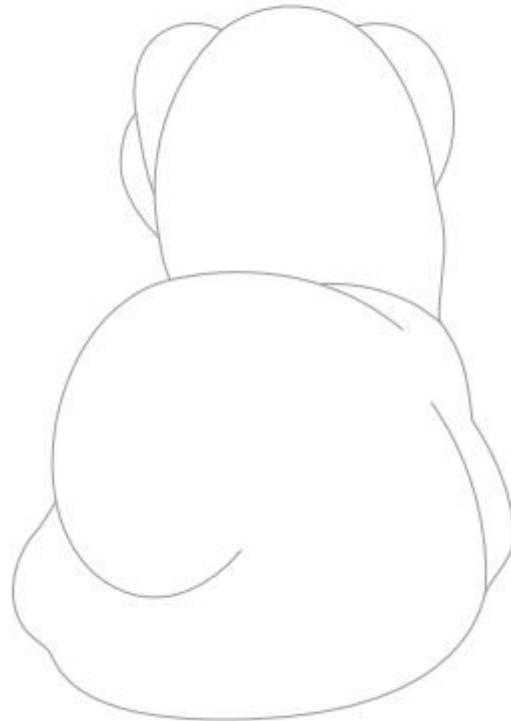

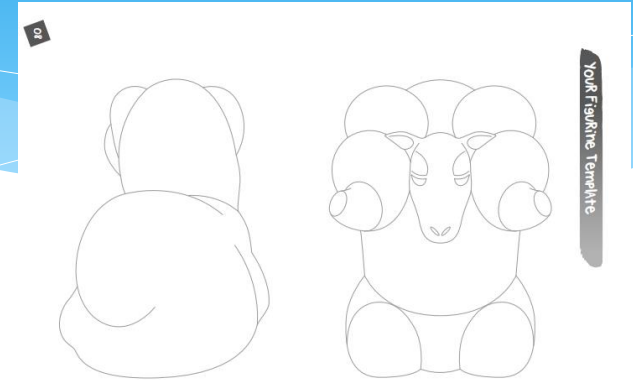
