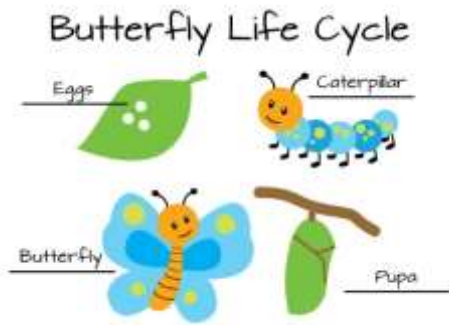




Nursery - Home Learning Week beginning 10.5.21

<p>Word Wise</p> 	<p>We are learning Phase 1 Phonics using 'Letters and Sounds'</p> <p>Make a collection of objects that start with s, a, t, p, n and i Lay them out and talk about the phonetic clues for each object E.g. tomato, begins with the phoneme 't', has 3 syllables and rhymes with shamato! Play a guessing game by giving clues for your child to guess.</p> <p>Enjoy this rhyme together https://youtu.be/J0lbSEOCmNM</p>	 <p>Can you draw a caterpillar? Remember to practise your name every day</p>
