'ey' likes to come at the end of words and sometimes in the middle.


Today, we are learning to read words containing **ey** saying /ee/.




ey is an alternative spelling for /ee/ and it usually comes at the end of a word.

monkey honey money























Sentence Time




Hidden Map Words
