- What is your favourite animal? Talk about what you know about different animals.




I am a

Reading every day is the key to your childs success. If you have your school reading books with you please practise reading them. Don't forget reading them more than once helps confidence and reading for fluency.


Your child has been given their own password and logins for Big Cat Collins ebooks just like we have in school- It is the same as in reception- login to read a new book or re-read your favourites.

Can you remember your sounds? You can find a sound mat on the school website?




Alphablocks are a great for helping us learn our sounds and help us to blend the sounds together. Watch some episodes on BBC iplayer or on Youtube.

Use these sentence starters:


